## FOUR SEASONS RESORT AND PRIVATE RESIDENCES ANGUILLA (FORMERLY VICEROY)

Set atop a lick of land between the beaches of Barnes and Meads bays, the rebranded resort, set to reopen in October 2016 plays perfectly with its surroundings: A modern, clean-lined exterior envelops the space in large glass windows, providing effortless views of both bay and beach, while the Kelly Wearstler-designed suites bring it back down to earth with organic elements like bleached blonde wood floors and tables carved from knotty, gnarled pieces of petrified wood.

At Cobà, Executive Chef Rafael Gonzalez makes the most of the island's fresh bounty by serving island-influenced classics like Jumbo lump crab cakes topped with tangy mango and papaya chutney. Kicks can also be had at the Sunset Lounge, where the name says it all, and you can take in the sights from the infinity pool with a Cuban cigar in one hand and a glass of aged rum in the other. And if the view from the morning after isn't quite so spectacular, hang tight—there are plenty of ways to get you back on track. With three championship tennis courts, a multi-level rock climbing wall, volleyball and basketball courts, and the chance to go scuba diving and snorkeling, you might leave in better shape than you arrived.
